ESOL Orientation Sessions

Orientation/assessment, 3.0 score or instructor permission required for ESOL classes.

I-BEST Classes

Integrated Basic Education and Skills Training (I-BEST)

I-BEST programs combine college-level professional-technical certificates with English language and basic skills instruction. Students have two teachers in each class. One focuses on professional-technical skills, the other teaches basic skills and English language skills. Basic skills include math, reading, writing, computer skills, student success strategies, and educational/career planning. For more information, call 360.475.7408.

Prerequisite: Orientation/qualifying score on state standardized assessment.

Welding (Shelton): This two-quarter program provides the knowledge and skills to perform precision metal cutting with a concentration on worker and equipment safety. It prepares basic skills and English language learners for entry-level metal cutting positions in the welding industry. Completers have the option to continue in the Welding Program.
