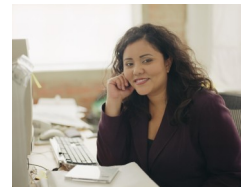


# 2009-2010 OPPORTUNITY GRANT

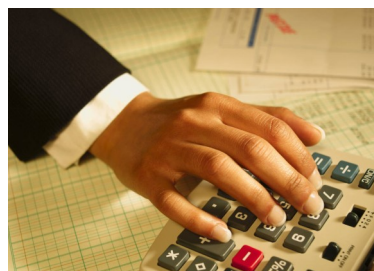
## STUDENT ELIGIBILITY
