Olympic College's College Level Intensive English (CLIE) is for international students who want to prepare for academic study at colleges and universities in the U.S.A. OC offers small classes and personal attention from each instructor. Most students who enroll in our CLIE continue their academic study at Olympic College for two years, then transfer to a four-year institution in the U.S.A. to complete their bachelor degree. CLIE credits (15 credits per quarter) count toward the Olympic College associate degree.



CLIE includes

- 20 classroom hours and 5 lab hours per week
- Each level takes one quarter with two modules of five or six weeks in length.
- A certificate will be awarded upon completion of each level.

Fall, winter and spring quarters last 11 weeks. Summer quarter is eight weeks. Intensive English Program quarters follow the same calendar as the academic program at Olympic College.

Housing Options

Homestay Program

Homestay offers students the opportunity to improve their communication skills, experience American culture on a personal and daily basis, and build a long-term relationship with an American host family.

Traditional Homestay

\$575/month*

(This option includes 5 dinners/week, usually Monday through Friday and all food for other meals each day including weekends.)

Room and Kitchen Access Homestay

\$400/month*

(Students may purchase, store and prepare their own food using the host's kitchen.)

Apartment Rentals
