

RESOLUTION NO. 12

WHEREAS: there is immediate and pressing need for the provision of adequate housing for students attending Olympic College; and

WHEREAS: this need has increased with the housing shortage in the Bremerton area in recent years; and


WHEREAS: it is the responsibility of the Board of Trustees under authority vested in it by Chapter 28, laws, Extraordinary Session, 1967, of the Washington State legislature that: "..... each board of trustees may establish or lease, operate, equip and maintain dormitories, food service facilities, bookstores and other self-supporting facilities connected with the operation of the Community College;" and

WHEREAS: previous authority has been granted the administration to proceed with necessary planning, and filing of applications for financing of a dormitory and food services.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED: That the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 3 does hereby adopt this resolution to proceed with necessary arrangements to secure this needed dormitory for Olympic College students by approving the application for funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

The Acting President of the College is authorized to proceed with the necessary arrangements to secure adequate housing for the students of Olympic College.
