DATE: Saturday, January 7 or Sunday January 22, 2012

CHECK-IN: 11:00 am

RENDEZVOUS DIRECTIONS

Meet at Howard Miller Steelhead Park (address: 5110 Railroad Ave, Rockport WA 98283). See PDF file with highway map. A GPS, www.mapquest.com or www.googlemaps.com has directions. It's a 3+ hour drive from Bremerton (160 miles). Hwy 520 & Hwy 20 are only 2 lane roads and weekend traffic during winter months may be slow. **If 30 minutes late you will miss the trip!**

Longer Route: Take WA-16 E to Tacoma, I-5 N to Burlington, take exit #230, and drive Hwy 20 E to Rockport. Turn right at Steelhead Park sign onto Alfred St – go 1/8 mile & turn left into the Park.

Shorter Route:

- 1) From Bremerton, take WA-16 E to Tacoma - go about 30 miles;
- 2) Take I-5 N – go 76.3 miles;
- 3) Take exit 208 for State Hwy 530 toward Arlington/Darrington – go.2 miles;
- 4) Turn right onto a-530 e – go 3.7 miles;
- 5) Turn left at WA-530 E/WA-9 N – go.1 miles;
- 6) Take the 1st right onto W Burke Ave/WA-530 E & continue to follow WA-530 E – go 27.6 miles;
- 7) At Darrington, take left at Seeman St – go. 3 miles;
- 8) Turn left at Emens Ave/WA-530 E & continue to follow WA-530 E – go 18.4 miles;
- 9) At Rockport, turn left at Howard Miller Steelhead Park sign (entrance is on north side of Skagit River Bridge).

Look for a Wildwater River Tours vehicle near Club House building at east end of park. If lost; call Rod 253-740-4445. For more information prior to trip, call 253-939-2151.
