RESOLUTION I

- WHEREAS: Each of the persons whose signature appears hereafter on this Resolution has been appointed by the Governor of the State of Washington on the recommendation of the numbers of the legislature whose residence is in Kitsap or Mason Counties to serve as a Trustee for the Washington Community College District Number 3, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 8, Sections 10 and 11, Laws, Extraordinary Session, 1967;
- WHEREAS: Each signator hereby accepts appointment and agrees to assume the duties, responsibilities, and authority vested by law and to abide by and enforce the regulations of the various State agencies empowered by law to exercise authority over the governance of the District;
- WHEREAS: Each Signator hereby declares himself to be a legal resident of Kitsap or Mason Counties, comprising the present boundaries of Washington Community College District Number 3, and a qualified elector thereof,
- WHEREAS: Each and all of us have, by drawing of lots, determined the length of time for which we are initially to serve,

WHEREAS: An election has been held at which a president and vice-president have been duly elected;

WHEREAS: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND PROCLAIMED BY THIS RESOLUTION WE are the Board of Trustees for Washington Community College District Number 3 and for Olympic College for the terms appearing beside our signatures below from this date until April 3 of the year in which our terms expire, or until our successors are appointed, and installed, and that due notification thereof be made to the Governor, the nominating committee, the Washington State Board for Community College Education and the constituents of this District.
