

2008-2009 Olympic College Verification Worksheet Federal Student Aid Programs

B. Family Information

Check the box(s) for those people who did not and are not required to file a 2007 Federal Income Tax Return and list the employer(s) and total income received in 2007 (use W-2 forms or other earning statements) for each of the people checked. Write NONE for any person that had no income from work.
