

If you do not already have a high school diploma:

*According to Washington State SHB 1758 (effective July 2009), individuals who enroll at Olympic College and complete an associate degree (two year diploma) of any type may also submit a written request and be awarded a high school diploma from the college. The law is retroactive and is valid both before and after the law went into effect.

Retroactive: All students who completed an associate degree at the College at any time may request a high school diploma if the graduate is either (a) 21 years and older or (b) has been a Running Start student at any time prior to earning the associate degree.

Please check one of the categories below if you wish to receive the high school diploma also. An additional \$10 fee is required.

I participated in Running Start in the past and have completed an associate degree at Olympic College.

I am a current Running Start student and I wish to receive a high school diploma through Olympic College at the same time as I receive the associate degree. I do not wish to receive a high school diploma through my former high school.

I am over the age of 21 years, have completed my associate degree in the past and wish to receive my high school diploma.

I am over the age of 21 years, will complete my associate degree at the next graduation and wish to receive my high school diploma at the same time as I receive the associate degree.
