



RESOLUTION NO. 47-0878

- WHEREAS the closure of 15th Street between Lincoln and Broadway and Chester Street between 13th and 16th Streets since the early 1970's was formally approved by the City Council of the City of Bremerton, and
- WHEREAS such streets have remained closed until the present date, and
- WHEREAS the Board of Trustees believes that the closure of said streets is vital to the health, safety and welfare of its students and staff, and
- WHEREAS the closure of said streets is consistent with the 1969 Master Plan of Olympic College, as discussed with City Officials, and
- WHEREAS the City of Bremerton has failed to demonstrate that it has considered any reasonable alternatives in lieu of reopening the streets, and
- WHEREAS the City of Bremerton has indicated its intention to permanently reopen the above referenced streets to vehicular traffic, and
- WHEREAS the City of Bremerton has failed to give reasonable consideration to the requirements of Section #504 of the Federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973 concerning handicapped students and citizens, and
- WHEREAS the City of Bremerton has failed to file an Environmental Impact Statement, and
- WHEREAS the Olympic College Board of Trustees believes that this action will adversely affect the health, safety and welfare of its students and staff, and
- WHEREAS the Olympic College Board of Trustees is opposed to the reopening of 15th Street and Chester Street by the City of Bremerton, now
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby declares that the acquisition of such streets within the campus perimeter is a public use and necessity and is necessary as a part of the College campus, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees direct that legal proceedings be commenced to condemn such streets as a public use and necessity as an integral part of the Olympic College campus.
