BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Olympic College that:

As the legal successor to the Board of Directors of the Bremerton School District and pursuant to the authority vested in it by RCW 28.85.140 (8), the Board hereby accepts any and all bequests, devises, and benefits provided for in the Last Will and Testament of Mr. John Bremer, together with the conditions attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Olympic College that in expression of sympathy to Edward Bremer on the death of his brother and in execution of a request in the will of John Bremer, Olympic College pledges a suitable memorial to the Bremer family, specifically

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Olympic College that the faith of John Bremer in Olympic College will manifest itself in an institution dedicated to serving Community College District No. 3 in ways suitable to the community.
