

2022-2023 Federal and State Work-Study Calendar

Summer Quarter:

Classes in Session: July 5th -- August 18th
Summer Break: August 19th -- September 18th
Blackout Dates: September 16th—September 18th

Fall Quarter:

Classes in Session: September 19th —December 9th
Winter Break: December 10th—January 2nd
Blackout Dates: January 1st—January 2nd

Winter Quarter:

Classes in Session: January 3rd —March 17th
Spring Break: March 18th —April 2nd
Blackout Dates: April 1st—April 2nd

Spring Quarter:

Classes in Session: April 3rd —June 16th
Pre-Summer Break: June 17th – June 30th

Work-Study Eligibility:

- Must be registered for a minimum of 6 credits each quarter
- Must be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- Must have available financial need *and* have been awarded Work-Study

If at any point during their employment a student fails to meet any of these requirements they must immediately stop working.

Available Work Hours:

- **While Class is in Session:** 19 hours per week maximum
- **During Quarter Breaks:** 40 hours per week maximum

Students must work with their supervisors to create a schedule that ensures they will not work beyond their awarded hours. If a student does work beyond what they were awarded, note that the funds will be subtracted from that supervisor's departmental budget.
