





If you have completed two quarters or more, what grade would you give your program?




What are your educational goals at Olympic College?




Where you able to find your first choice program at Olympic College (in other words, is the program you're currently taking your first choice for an educational program?



What program were you looking for or what program(s) do you think Olympic College should add?





I feel every student should have an advisor, mine sadly passed away my first quarter, i am now in my 5th, and just got a person assigned to me. I went to advising every quarter because I needed help signing up for classes. I didn't know what classes I needed, when to take them, how to register, how to use the catalogue, and because of not knowing these things and being a student who fell through the cracks, my dreams of walking a stage with fellow students and graduating on time doesn't look like it will happen. I'll still graduate and get my degree, and I suppose that is the most important thing, but as a student who dropped out of HS and obtained her GED, I always dreamed of walking the stage in full regalia, in front of loved ones, graduating with my fellow students. I'm 50, so this was huge for me, I feel if the student success coaches were better trained in knowing what classes actually met what requirements, I would have been able to graduate on time. every time I went to advising for help, I would point out my advisor passed and I was without one...to which I was told "yes, that was sad, you'll get a new one" I was never notified of my advisors passing until I was at least in the middle of my 2nd quarter, and nobody followed through with me to see if I needed anything in between advisors, even though at every meeting, I would say, 'I don't know what to take, I don't know how to register, and I don't know how to get to or use the catalogue" they simply did it for me, it would have been nice to have been shown how to do these things. When I left school, we were still using DOS and had just upgraded from floppy disks to 3.5 disks....my whole working career in healthcare, was paper charts, fax machines, computers were used by managers or unit secretaries...there is a class on how to use canvas, and how to be successful with college, maybe adding catalogue tutorial, and how to find what classes you need and in what order could be done so we have all the info we need to be successful with college, and how to register for them.
