Meeting Summary

TV Show Themed Icebreaker Meeting

Other participants shared a variety of TV show and movie preferences, including Breaking Bad, Deadpool, Gravity Falls, Star Trek, Firefly, and The Clone Wars. The meeting continued with introductions and brief mentions of club affiliations and roles, but no significant decisions, alignments, or action items were discussed.

Sustainability Club Earth Week Plans

The meeting began with introductions from various club representatives, where participants shared their favorite TV shows or movies. The discussion then shifted to budget requests, with the Sustainability Club presenting their plans for Earth Week in April. They outlined three main events: a panel of speakers, a film screening, and the construction

of bat boxes, along with associated supplies and prizes for a raffle. The club also requested funds for composting initiatives and maintenance at the Bremerton property.

Wellness Club

The Wellness Club requested \$373 for student-centered programming, including tea stations, coloring events, and sensory stress relief activities.

Engineering Club

The Engineering Club requested a resupply of materials and components for their workshops, including 3D printer filament and electronics parts for student hands-on learning experiences for a total of \$730

AI Education Hardware Funding Request

James Duffy, the AI ambassador of the OC Computer Club, presented a funding request for \$1,279 to set up dedicated hardware on the Olympic College site for students to learn about AI. The club aims to provide students with the skills to run AI in a secure, containerized environment, which is increasingly sought after by employers. Michelle Collins, president of KVSU OC Chapter, made a motion for the club's budget requests to be considered and approved, pending the submission of correct information. The club plans to reach out to other campuses and use the equipment for training sessions under an MOU.
