## Meeting Summary

### Quick recap

The meeting focused on planning and updates for upcoming club events and budget requests. The primary discussion centered around a club fair scheduled for May 20th from 11 AM to 1 PM, which will be held outdoors on the green with indoor backup options in the BSC. Several clubs presented budget requests including BSN Club for nursing pins and lab coats, KBSU's Black Student Union for an end-of-year celebration, Ping Pong Club for a pizza party tournament, and LPN for a fundraiser involving discounted sports tickets. The meeting also addressed significant funding changes for next year, with Congress facing budget cuts requiring clubs to increasingly rely on fundraising rather than direct funding from student activity fees. Additionally, the Asian Pacific Islander Club announced a cultural showcase event planned for May 27th, inviting other clubs to participate or volunteer.

### Summary

#### Club Fair and Budget Updates

The meeting covered several key updates and announcements. Spring club fair was scheduled for May 20th from 11 to 1 PM outdoors on the green, with indoor BSC space as a backup option. The Director of Clubs & Student Life requested club flyers for advertising and discussed potential accommodations for electricity needs and performance spaces. Significant budget changes were announced, with Club Congress facing cuts requiring clubs to increasingly rely on fundraising for events and conferences rather than relying solely on allocated funds. Finally, Rodgie from the Asian Pacific Islander Club invited other clubs to participate in their cultural showcase event on May 27th from 11 to 2 PM, seeking performers, flag bearers, and volunteers.



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### **BSN Club's Budget Request**

The meeting discussed budget constraints and guidelines for student activities, particularly regarding the BSN Club's pinning ceremony and lab coats funding. It was clarified that service and activity fees have strict guidelines preventing the use of funds for items like pins and lab coats, though these could be purchased through fundraising conducted through the foundation account. The discussion included plans to connect with the BSN Club later in the week to help pivot their approach and explore fundraising options for approved expenses like decorations and programs.

### **KBSU Budget Request Discussion**

KBSU presented a budget request for the KSAP Black Student Union Olympic College chapter's end-of-year celebration in June, seeking \$1,500 to fund various activities including fundraiser supplies, t-shirts, cultural earrings, and a field trip to the Northwest African American Museum. The discussion focused on adjusting the budget allocation, with them suggesting removing the food component from the June celebration and potentially revisiting that later.

### **Ping Pong Club Budget Request**

The meeting focused on budget requests and event planning. The Ping Pong Club presented a request for \$354 to host a pizza party and tournament on May 13th from 12-2:30 PM, which would include a \$15 Starbucks gift card prize. The club president confirmed that other clubs could participate in the tournament, though it was initially planned for Ping Pong Club members only. The voting process for budget approvals was explained, with forms to be sent to the conference email and voting due by Friday.

### **LPN Budget Request**

The meeting focused on a fundraising initiative for a student event on May 31st, where students planned to purchase 37 discounted tickets at \$18 each to resell at \$30 each, with a total estimated cost of \$666. The student presenter mentioned that the fundraising form requires approval from multiple parties including the presenter, dean of leadership and engagement, and the foundation before proceeding. The meeting also covered upcoming club events, with plans for another club meeting within two and a half weeks, and discussions about indoor vs outdoor event locations and electricity needs.
