Meeting Summary

Quick recap

This was the final budget request meeting of the fiscal year where club members voted on budget allocations and shared their successful achievements from the year. Marrelli Anderson, Director of Clubs and Student Life, facilitated the meeting which included introductions, club reflection icebreakers where clubs shared their most successful events, and announcements about club activities and awards. The Sustainability Club presented their budget request for new equipment and supplies, with Aiden explaining they needed storage containers, compost bins, and gardening supplies for campus activities. Several clubs received congratulations for recent awards and successful events, including Alianza, International Club, and Engineering Club. The conversation ended with important reminders about mandatory quarterly update forms due the following Friday and announcements about summer club activities and upcoming transition meetings for next year's leadership.

Summary

Final Budget Request Meeting

The meeting began with technical difficulties and late arrivals, with participants being given extra time to join. The student facilitator announced this was the final budget request meeting of the fiscal year, indicating that future club congress meetings would focus on preparing for next year rather than voting on budgets. The meeting was scheduled for two hours but was expected to be shorter than planned.

Club Achievements and Successes

The meeting featured club members sharing what they considered their most successful achievements of the year during an icebreaker session. Clubs reported various successes including high turnout at events like Linux Fest, Earth Week, tournaments, cultural showcases, and workshops, with many clubs noting growth in membership and successful collaborations with other organizations. The Director of Clubs and Student Life,



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Marrelli Anderson, praised the overall success of club fairs, particularly the spring event which had excellent attendance.

Club Fair and Sustainability Updates

The meeting began with congratulations to clubs for their successful spring club fair and announcements about summer club activities. Several clubs received awards at recent student award ceremonies, including Alianza, International Club, and Engineering Club. Aiden from the Sustainability Club presented a budget request for new equipment including compost bins, storage containers, gloves, and other supplies to support their expanded operations, with clarification that all materials must remain on campus and be used only by students.

Club Feedback Voting Process

The student announced a voting process for club feedback, specifically asking participants to scan a QR code on the flyer to provide input on campus Wi-Fi issues. They clarified that voting on the Engineering Club budget item should be skipped due to a mix-up and promised to send out an email with the form before leaving that day, with results to be announced on Friday.

Quarterly Update Forms Deadline

Marrelli Anderson announced that quarterly update forms must be submitted by next Friday, emphasizing that this is mandatory for all clubs and failure to submit could result in suspension. They informed the group that this would be the last budget request meeting, and announced their departure from the position next year, with a new person taking over who will have a shadowing day, hopefully with a club conference meeting. The student also discussed summer activity plans, noting that clubs interested in staying active during summer need to communicate with them, and mentioned upcoming training sessions about fundraising and next year's processes.
