CNCTE 004—6 clock hours; 3 hours face-to-face OC Bremerton Introduction to Career and Technical Education Teacher Certification Program Times: 1pm – 4pm Building. 4, room 108 Instructor: Anduiza, M. & Hatfield, Sara Certified teachers will learn the process for waiving courses and adding a CTE endorsement. Business/Industry professionals will gain insight on how to transition from their industry to the CTE classroom/laboratory and attain a CTE certification. Participants will review current research on adolescent brain development and the corresponding relationship to teaching and learning. *Class will continue via Distance Learning on Canvas until Friday, August 2.	CNCTE 008 – 30 clock hours Zoom History & Philosophy of CTE Times: 9am – 12pm zoom Instructors: Sara Hatfield & Susie Nass This course explores the history, philosophy, legislation and organizational/curricular structure of career and technical education by examining state and federal legislation and critical reports. *Class will continue via Distance Learning on Canvas until Friday, August 2.	 14 courses are required to complete the CTE Teacher Preparation Program at a cost of \$4076. If documentation allows for course waivers, the program cost is less. 7 courses are required: Introduction to CTE Teacher Preparation Program Student Leadership/ Development CTE History & Philosophy Occupational Analysis & Skills Standards Safety in the CTE Classroom Work Based Learning Culminating Project 7 classes may be waived with proof of competency and approval of your CTE Director.
