### **The Factoring System**

Once we receive your application and supporting documents, an admission score will be determined according to the following factoring system and candidates ranked:

#### 1. Cumulative GPA of Prerequisite Courses

(ENGL& 101, BIOL& 241, and CHEM& 121 [or CHEM& 141/151 and CHEM& 142/152]) Note: A minimum grade of 2.0 must be earned in each prerequisite course

#### 2. BIOL& 242 (if completed before the March 31<sup>st</sup> application deadline) = 1 point

**Note:** BIOL& 242 must be completed with a grade point of 2.0 or higher by the end of spring quarter of the year you apply for admission to the Nursing (RN) ATA Pathway. If BIOL& 242 is completed **after** the March 31<sup>st</sup> application deadline, the factor point for BIOL& 242 <u>will not be awarded.</u>

**4. Other Course Completion** (To earn these points the course MUST be completed by March 31<sup>st</sup> and a minimum grade of 2.0 achieved).

**5. Rollover** (for applicants who are eligible but not accepted on their first attempt). The roll-over point will be awarded one time only = **1 point** 

## Maximum factor points possible for first time applicants: 15 points Maximum factor points possible for rollover applicants: 16 points

# Applicants are ranked according to total factor points earned. In the event of a tie, the following tie breakers will be used:

- <u>1<sup>st</sup> Tie Breaker</u>: Combined **GPA** of prerequisite courses (ENGL&101, BIOL& 241, CHEM&121 [or CHEM&141/151 &142/152]).
- <u>2<sup>nd</sup> Tie Breaker</u>: Number of support courses completed (BIOL&260, PSYC&100 or PSYC102, ENGL&102, MATH&107/141) by March 31<sup>st</sup>.
- <u>3<sup>rd</sup> Tie Breaker</u>: Combined **GPA** of support courses (BIOL&260, PSYC&100 or PSYC102, ENGL&102, MATH&107/141).
- <u>4<sup>th</sup> Tie Breaker</u>: Overall college-level cumulative GPA (all colleges attended).
- 5th Tie Breaker: Reading Comprehension score on the ACCUPLACER Placement Test.
