Prerequisite and Support Courses

Application Deadline: All application and admission forms must be submitted to the Office of Admissions by

August 31st of the academic year you wish to be considered for admission

Program Start Date: Winter quarter of each year (5 quarters or 1.5 years in length)

Care Quality Assurance Commission

A current unencumbered Practical Nursing license in the state of Washington is required to apply to the LPN to RN pathway
