

VL-BSN Pathway Admission Factoring System

Once application and supporting documents are received, an admission score is determined, and candidates are ranked according to the following factoring system:

- Cumulative GPA of Prerequisite Courses (ENGL& 101, CHEM& 121, [OR CHEM 141/151 AND 142/152], BIOL& 241, BIOL& 242, BIOL& 260, and PSYC& 100.)

Note: A minimum grade of 2.0 must be earned in each prerequisite course. Points are assigned as follows:

GPA	2.7 – 2.89	2.9 – 3.09	3.1 – 3.29	3.3 – 3.49	3.5 – 3.69	3.7 – 4.0

To receive factor points, courses must be completed with 2.0 or higher by the application deadline

*For MATH& 107/141, any college level math class other than statistics will be accepted

- Roll-over (for applicants who are eligible but not accepted on their first attempt). The roll-over point will be awarded one time only.

Maximum points possible for first time applicants: 12 points

Maximum points possible for rollover applicants: 13 points

Applicants are ranked according to total number of factor points. In the event of a tie, the following tie breakers will be used:

1st Tie Breaker: Combined GPA of prerequisite courses

2nd Tie Breaker: Number of years of active clinical practice as evidenced by resume
