## VL-BSN Pathway Admission Factoring System

Once application and supporting documents are received, an admission score is determined, and candidates are ranked according to the following factoring system:

1. Cumulative GPA of Prerequisite Courses (ENGL\& 101, CHEM\& 121, [OR CHEM 141/151 AND 142/152], BIOL\& 241, BIOL\& 242, BIOL\& 260, and PSYC\& 100.)

Note: A minimum grade of 2.0 must be earned in each prerequisite course. Points are assigned as follows:

To receive factor points, courses must be completed with 2.0 or higher by the application deadline
*For MATH\& 107/141, any college level math class other than statistics will be accepted
4. Roll-over (for applicants who are eligible but not accepted on their first attempt). The roll-over point will be awarded one time only.

Applicants are ranked according to total number of factor points. In the event of a tie, the following tie breakers will be used:
$1^{\text {st }}$ Tie Breaker: Combined GPA of prerequisite courses
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Tie Breaker: Number of years of active clinical practice as evidenced by resume
