## **Prerequisite and Support Courses**

#### An Information Session is the first step for anyone considering a Nursing Program at Olympic College.

**Application Deadline:** All application and admission forms must be submitted to the Office of Admissions by **September 10<sup>th</sup>** for consideration for the Fall 2021 cohort.

Program Start Date: Fall quarter of each year (8 quarters or 2 years in length)

**For LPN applicants:** A current unencumbered Practical Nursing license in the state of Washington is required to apply to the VL-BSN pathway

**For Veteran applicants:** Current or former honorably discharged military medics who have successfully completed US Air Force Course L8AQJ4N031 01AA (4NOX1) and US Air Force skill level 5 or the US Army Practical Nursing Specialist 68C (Army68WM6) are eligible to apply

## **Prerequisite Courses**
