The Olympic College CTE program allows current teachers to waive completed courses to obtain a teaching certificate. Documentation of competencies is required, and the process is reviewed by the program’s advisory committee.

Or, The process for certified teachers to waive courses and add a CTE endorsement. Participants will review current research on adolescent brain development and the corresponding relationship to teaching and learning.</p>	<p><b>CNPRF 009—20 hours 6 hours FF \$185</b></p> <p><b>9986 – Occupational Analysis and Skills Standard</b> <b>Instructor: Cynthia Blinkinsop</b></p> <p>This course examines labor market information to discover key characteristics of jobs; purposes, task characteristics, task duties, and necessary skills.  Participants will complete an occupational analysis using available labor market information to assist in determining critical job skills components to include in a high school/skills center program/course.</p>	<p><b>CNPRF 015—6 hours \$59</b></p> <p><b>Culminating CTE Teacher Project</b></p> <p>This culminating course allows the participant to share his/her process of becoming a certified CTE teacher and enhances abilities to present information about CTE programs to varied audiences.  <b><u>Participant will communicate how he/she will fulfill this requirement with the Program Manager, Mourine Anduiza (email address below).</u></b></p>
