- Roth moved to add 'ORCSYNC' to the meeting agenda-- 2nd by Miller. Approved by all present ASOC members.]
- Club charters- Roth Introduced presidents of the present unchartered clubs.
- Encounter Club--Religious affiliation, open for students to become more informed. Roth motioned to approve club for chartering--2nd by Miller-- Approved by all present ASOC members.
- Clay Club--Karen Minute:--expand experiences of ceramic students, generate income for club activities...1-2 workshops/sales per quarter, donate work to community, work with the food line and want to promote the college in a positive manner Roth motioned to approve club for chartering--2nd by Waring-Enriquez. help out around school...Roth motioned to approve club for chartering--2nd Miller.
Approved by all present ASOC members.

- LBGTQ+ Club --Faith and Chris-- Wants it to be based from welcoming those of this community and their allies who strive to assist them in their struggles. local community representatives for them to come in and talk about sex assault and things that are encouraging of people of that nature--Roth motioned to approve club for chartering--2nd by Miller. Approved by all present ASOC members.
- Strategy Club--Tabitha and Deanna--play any game that requires the brain to think and to use a larger portion of ones brain to expand ones capabilities. Hold tournaments that allow 16+ ppl that arrive to these events....Roth motioned to approve club for chartering--2nd by Waring-Enriquez. Approved by all present ASOC members.

- Phil Silva allowed Beaushaw to gain knowledge of stores that will help with food. Fredmeyer, Kroger,...etc. Arvin may have more info. on this. contact foundations about this item to ensure we are not asking for money/food donations from places they have already asked from.
- MESA \$3000 scholarship overspent dollars and needs to approval for this overspent funds by their department-- Motioned by Beaushaw to approve--2nd by Miller Approved by all present ASOC members.
- Check for the Associate Dean for Student Leadership and Success Position interview on 31st October; seems to be the same date as Club Fair in BSC.
- ORCSYNC--Looking into getting a software program that will allow us to provide co-curricular permits for students' transcripts (i.e. those participating in the positions in clubs) 3-year price range was given \$19-26,000. Motioned by Roth to look further into the program--2nd by Enriquez. Approved by all present ASOC members.
