Participants will review current research on adolescent brain development and the corresponding relationship to teaching and learning.</p>	<p><b>Culminating CTE Teacher Project</b></p> <p>This culminating course allows the participant to share his/her process of becoming a certified CTE teacher and enhances abilities to present information about CTE programs to varied audiences.</p> <p><b><u>Participant will communicate how he/she will fulfill this requirement with the Program Manager, Mourine Anduiza (email address below).</u></b></p>
