Bachelor of Applied Science in Information Systems (180 cr)

Graduates strategically plan, manage and apply information technology solutions to business processes and challenges. Much of the curriculum is aligned with in-demand industry certifications. Topics include business processes, software development, Web, networking, information assurance, project management, analytics, communication, teamwork and leadership. The program includes opportunities for work-based learning, internships and capstone projects.

Information Systems Specialist Associate in Applied Science (101-113 cr)

Graduates of this degree will be eligible for entrance into the Olympic College Bachelor of Information Systems degree program. Students take 62 credits of computer information systems courses, then select one of the following three emphases to complete their degree coursework:

- Security
- Networking
- Web Development
- Software Development
