Thanks for reaching out to Olympic College to learn more about the Career Technical Education (CTE) Teacher Preparation program. By way of introduction, my name is Mourine ("MO") Anduiza, and I am the Program Manager. Please feel free to reach me via email at manduiza@olympic.edu. I work part time but do expect an answer most times within 48 hours.

The program is approved by the State of Washington's Professional Educator Standards Board and the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) issues certificates/endorsements based on program completion.

6000 hours of occupational experience are required for admission. You will earn a "V" code in a specialty area matching your occupational experience as reviewed by OSPI. The program consists of 13 classes, some of which can be waived, if you are a current teacher. The program cost is less than \$4000 and can be completed in less than a year since classes are all online -Zoom and Canvas. You work at your pace; however, it is highly recommended that you start with CNCTE 004 - the Introduction to the CTE Teacher Preparation program at Olympic College, which is offered quarterly.

All courses are offered twice a year except for Instructional Strategies. Quick Jump is a popular option with teachers - the required five courses are offered the last week of June, and teacher candidates can complete the assignments via Canvas which are due the first Friday in August. The annual and quarterly schedules are posted on the website. At the present time, registration is completed by contacting Sue Ahrens, Program Coordinator, at sahrens@olympic.edu. Registration for QUICK JUMP opens around May 15th.
