B. Information/Action Items:

- I. **Budget Management Features Through Orgsync:** This will assist in all of the accounting done through clubs and for ASOC. Will provide current and up to date records. A total of 6,250 will be broken into three payments for 30 months of service. Motion was passed by Nic Shakley for \$3,750 out of the 2015-2016 budget to be allocated to this service. The first payment of \$1,250 will be expected within 30 days of the service being implemented. The second payment of \$2,500 is expected by January 27, 2016. Anthony Miller seconded the motion and it was passed without addition comments.

- II. **ASOC Constitution Edits:** All references to ASOC has been changed to SGOC. All references to Associated Students of Olympic College has been changed to Student Government of Olympic College. Changed position roll over to make all positions have to reapply each year. Changed the number of student signatures applicants must reach to be on the ballot to 100 signatures

for Bremerton positions, 75 signatures for Poulsbo positions, and 50 signatures for Shelton positions. Added in stronger procedures for impeaching positions. Implemented clear guidelines for maintaining positions, notably that each government position must have at least 5 credits per academic year at their respective campus. Added in the new start date so student government employees may start working the beginning of Summer quarter. Nic Shakley motioned for this change and L'Marie Davis seconded the motion.

III. ASOC Name Change: ASOC will from now on be referred to as SGOC. Associated Students of Olympic College will from now on be referred to as Student Government of Olympic College. L'Marie Davis motioned for this change and Anthony Miller seconded the motion.

IV. Budget Proposal for Campus Food Banks: Starting in the fall quarter, out of our respective 2015-2016 budgets, the SGOC allocated funds to stock campus food banks/cabinets. In Bremerton, \$1000 is allocated per quarter. In Poulsbo, \$100 is allocated per quarter. In Shelton, \$350 is allocated per quarter. Anthony Miller motioned for this change and Susan Ronald seconded this motion.
