### Stephen "BJ" Quance Memorial Scholarship William H. Upton Naval and Military Lodge# 206 2022/2023 Academic Year

General Information: Students applying for this scholarship must be enrolled as full time students at Olympic College, and must be entering at least their second quarter of college study. One scholarship of \$2000 will be awarded annually.

#### Scholarship Criteria/Eligibility:

- Applicants must be a United States Citizen and provide proof of Washington State Residency.
- Applicants must have a cumulative college level grade point average of 3.0 or equivalent scholastic standing to qualify for scholarship, and must maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.5 each quarter to remain eligible for this scholarship.
- Applicants must submit an official, sealed grade transcript through the last quarter of enrollment from all colleges and universities attended.
- Applicants must submit three original (not photocopied) letters of recommendation addressed to the Stephen "BJ" Quance Memorial Scholarship Committee. The letters must be from individuals that have intimate knowledge of the applicant's academic, personal or professional background. Letters from academic references, employers, religious leaders, and Masonic friends or relatives are preferable.
- Applicants must submit a 100 word goal statement.
- Applicants should be prepared for a personal interview with members of the Stephen "BJ" Quance Memorial Scholarship Committee.

**Application information and requirements:** The attached application packet (with your permanent Washington address), official student transcript (in a sealed envelope), three letters of recommendation, and your personal goal statement must be received by the Stephen "BJ" Quance Memorial Scholarship Committee by no later than May 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. **Late and incomplete application packages will be disqualified.**
