

TRANSITION TO ASSOCIATE DEGREE IN NURSING (TADN)

Opportunities abound for nurses in a wide variety of settings!

The Olympic College TADN program offers a 1.5 year curriculum to prepare qualified LPNs to become Registered Nurses. The program is approved by the Washington State Nursing Care Quality Assurance Commission and accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Nursing Education (ACEN).

Graduates of the TADN program earn an Associate in Technical Arts degree which qualifies them to take the NCLEX-RN exam for licensure as a Registered Nurse.

Interested candidates must complete a series of classes prior to program application and are awarded factor points based on class completion and grades.

Following acceptance to the program, students must complete a transition class, four quarters of program classwork and maintain a minimum of a 2.2 grade in each class.

Prerequisites (must be completed with at least a 2.0 grade prior to program application):

1. ENGL& 101 Composition 1
2. CHEM& 121 Intro to Chemistry
3. BIOL& 241 Anatomy & Physiology 1
4. BIOL& 242 Anatomy & Physiology 2
5. BIOL& 260 Microbiology
6. PSYCH& 100 Intro to Psychology
7. Accuplacer Reading Comprehension Score of at least 260 (Next Generation Version).

Note: Some of these classes have other entry requirements.

Program Classes you may take prior to acceptance into the program (require a minimum grade of 2.2, except Dosage Calculation which requires at least a 3.7 grade.):
